Our newest addition provides an opportunity to develop job skills and work force abilities through volunteer experience with the focus on future employment. Monthly evaluations and assessments provide references needed to help obtain a job within the community. Participants of Pre-Voc have recently decided to change our name to Open Door because of all of the opportunities they feel have been opened as a result of this program.

What do we do?

We volunteer at various sites assisting with the organization and repackaging of food and clothing donations, counting and repackaging medical supplies, farm work, office work, and much more. We also provide transportation to and from our various work sites.

When does Open Door take place?

Open Door runs Monday through Thursday from 10:00am to 2:00pm. We have two ten minute breaks and a thirty minute lunch break during our shift. On Monday and Wednesday we work in the Aurora/Denver area, and on Tuesday and Thursday we work in the Littleton/Highlands Ranch area. By working out of different locations we are providing convenience and availability for individuals of all areas we serve.
